In case of an emergency involving chemical substances guidance is necessary to indicate emergency response and recovery workers how to proceed and protect themselves from unintended exposures. The following resources are aimed to provide information and guidance related to the safe management of chemical substances.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE RESOURCES

Facilities must submit MSDSs (or SDSs), or a list of hazardous chemicals, to their State Emergency Response Commission (SERC), Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) and local fire department. Facilities must also submit an annual inventory of these chemicals by March 1 of each year to their SERC, LEPC and local fire department.
