Poverty Quick Facts. 38.1 million people (11.8 percent) lived in poverty in 2018, down from 12.3 percent in 2017. More than 16 percent of children (11.9 million) lived in poverty in 2018. The 2018 poverty rate was much higher for African Americans (20.8 percent) and Hispanics (17.6 percent) than for whites (8.1 percent).
