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I Me Mine Myself

MY and MINE. Use my before the word, and use mine after the word: Paul is my friend. Paul is a friend of mine. Those are my glasses. Those glasses are mine. MYSELF. The word myself is used in two cases: As a reflexive pronoun – when “I” is both the subject AND the object. I gave myself a haircut. (This means I cut MY own hair)

Pronouns Chart - I, ME, MY, MINE, MYSELF

Use ‘my’ before the word, and use ‘mine’ after the word. Remember ‘my’ is always followed by noun where as mine replaces the noun. John is my friend. John is a friend of mine. Those are my glasses. Those glasses are mine. MYSELF. The pronoun “myself” should only be used when you are performing the action on yourself.

Myself is a reflexive pronoun. It refers back to the subject of the sentence. Use myself instead of me when the object is the same person as the subject. In other words, use myself when you have already used I in a sentence, but you are still talking about yourself. Myself becomes the object. I bought myself a new car! I gave myself a manicure. Don't worry.

Me and mine are both first person singular pronouns, but me is personal, while mine is possessive. They cannot be freely exchanged. Me is a substitute for first person subject nouns. Mine indicates possession or ownership.
