Inclusion and exclusion criteria should be listed separately. Criteria should include details of all relevant descriptors necessary for eligible centres/participants to be included in the trial, or criteria that would disqualify otherwise eligible centres/participants.

On one hand, wide inclusion criteria should be chosen in order to demonstrate safety and effectiveness for a large group of patients. On the other hand, there are many ethical and scientific reasons to define exclusion criteria.4 The resulting subjective selection of inclusion and exclusion criteria should be a balance of these two considerations.

They are determined after setting the research question usually before the search is conducted, however scoping searches may need to be undertaken to determine appropriate criteria. Many different factors can be used as inclusion or exclusion criteria.

Inclusion criteria is everything that a study must have in order to be included in your review. Exclusion criteria are the factors that would make a study ineligible to be included in your review. These criteria can include dates, how a study was designed, population, outcomes, etc.
