The High Court's judgement was that there was no specific Kenyan statute or common law on burial, and the Kenyan courts were obliged to consider customary law if at least one party to a case was subject to or affected by it. If Otieno was subject to Luo customary law, he should be buried according to Luo customs as outlined by the clan.

Customary law does allow polygamy, but the groom will only be allowed to legally marry another bride if the High Court has given an order that regulates the matrimonial property system of the marriages. What's more, a customary marriage must be registered at the Department of Home Affairs within three (3) months of all the proceedings.

Customary Marriages The legislation introduces key changes to the way in which customary marriages are contracted. As noted above, it requires that parties to all customary marriages be at least 18 years of age and makes registration of customary marriages mandatory. (Id. §§ 3, 11, & 54.)
