People in rural areas have slightly higher rates of risk of poverty or social exclusion. On average, EU residents in rural areas were slightly more likely to live at risk of poverty or social exclusion than those in urban areas (23.9 % in rural areas compared with 22.6 % in cities) in 2017 (see Figure 9).

A myriad of factors likely underpin the 'stickiness' of the Indigenous poverty gap – geographical and political exclusion, historical oppression, limited infrastructure and physical capital assets, heightened exposure to risk, etc. – but there is emerging evidence that investing in early childhood development and reducing discrimination are especially critical keys to unlocking the indigenous poverty trap.

Poverty is deprivation due to a lack of resources, both material and non-material, e.g. income, housing, health, education, knowledge and culture. It requires a threshold to measure it; Social exclusion is being unable to participate in society because of a lack of resources that are normally available to the general population.
